AJ Villanueva has been an avid musician since he was young.

When he completed his music degree from the top university in the Philippines, he had already set his eyes on a path that would fulfill his musical dreams. But he would soon discover that God had bigger plans for him.



AJ dreamed of going abroad to study with a virtuoso teacher as is the practice for classical musicians. He applied to study overseas three times, but each time he was rejected. "As an achiever ever since I was young, all three times disappointed me to the point of depression," shared AJ. But during those moments, AJ began to see God's hand at work. He felt God calling him to equip church musicians, not only with skill but also with sound theology.



GRACE FACULTY HIGHLIGHTS

DOCTORAL DISSERTATION TO BE PUBLISHED



Ken Wilson, MD, DPhil

Grace School of Theology is blessed to have one of today's foremost Augustinian scholars serving on our faculty. Dr. Ken Wilson, Professor of Systematic Theology and Church History, spent years studying Augustine, ultimately choosing to make him the focus of his doctoral studies at the University of Oxford. Through his research, Dr. Wilson uncovered Augustine's syncretistic theological revisions, still vibrant in church doctrine more than 1500 years later.

Only a handful of people in the world have read all of Augustine's extant works, and Dr. Wilson may be one of only two scholars who have read the massive Augustinian collection in the order it was written (chronologically). This chronological analysis exposed that "Augustine departed from what the earliest church fathers believed about people's freedom to choose God," says Wilson. "The early church did not view God as deterministic, but Augustine changed that by combining Christianity with Gnostic Manichaeism, Stoicism, and Neoplatonism." Because of Augustine's immersion in Greek philosophy

(Stoicism and Neoplatonism) and Gnostic Manichaeism, his version of Christianity became deterministic – everything is unilaterally predetermined by God.

Dr. Wilson's work has been praised as groundbreaking by scholars from a wide range of theological views, and his dissertation will be available in September from Mohr Siebeck, the world's premier academic publisher. The title is *Augustine's Conversion from Traditional Free Choice to 'Non-Free' Free Will*. GRACE DEFIES BOUNDARIES

Dr. Fernando Abella, Director of Grace's Spanish Bible Program, is experiencing the boundary-defying power of God's grace firsthand. Born in Cuba three years after Fidel Castro's regime assumed power, Dr. Abella was raised with a communist philosophy that caused him to doubt even the existence of God. He lived on the island nation into his young adulthood, but his family miraculously received visas from Costa Rica which allowed them to leave.

Needless to say, the recently signed collaborative agreement with Los Pinos Nuevos Evangelical Convention in Cuba was an incredibly moving experience for him and the seminary, giving Dr. Abella the opportunity to return to his homeland to preach and teach about the love of Christ.

As a young man, Dr. Abella saw God miraculously answer prayers on behalf of his family, so he felt compelled to visit the

local church. During that first visit, the pastor preached from Job 19:25, "I know my redeemer lives." He trusted Christ that very day and has been serving Him ever since. However, Dr. Abella never anticipated how God would bring his life and ministry full circle. Grace will begin classes in Cuba on July 3, 2017, at Iglesia Bautista "Puerta del Cielo" (First Baptist Church "Door of Heaven") in Baracoa, Cuba, with an initial estimate of 30 students.

"This is the same church where I believed in Jesus. It is amazing how things are happening this way. God is at work," he says.

A dedication service is being planned with 1,000+ people from various churches in the city expected to attend. This is a tremendous opportunity to bring the message of grace to Cuba, so please join us in praying for Dr. Abella and other members of the Grace family who will be ministering there this summer.



The Grace Connection

Reaching Alabama and Beyond

When God awakens an idea in the heart of a gifted businessman, things happen – and often quickly. That's the story of Grace School of Theology's campus in Trussville, Alabama, just outside Birmingham. Through divine connections among those who share Grace's heart and passion, God is fueling our vision to develop spiritual leaders in every nation.

"The statistics tell us that 80% of Christians do not read their Bible regularly. We are becoming a biblically illiterate generation," says Dave Nichols, a Birmingham area businessman. "Because of that, I felt a burden to get the Word of God taught to young people in the right way."

Not quite sure how to begin, but confident in what God had called him to do, Dave began sharing his vision with several people involved in Christian education and received a lot of encouragement to start a Bible college in his community. Teaming up with a fellow church member and businessman Robbie Roberts, the two men met, shared, and prayed about offering solid biblical education in their community, and a grace connection was forged.

Robbie dove into the research and feasibility study using the profile of the type of school he and Dave had defined. As he reviewed accredited Christian colleges and schools, Grace School of Theology's profile fit the model of what they envisioned for Alabama. He placed a call to Dr. Al Letting, Grace's Vice President of Academic Affairs, which sparked a series of prayerful conversations about a partnership in Alabama.

"It was incredible to find a school that was like-minded. The alignment in doctrinal position was paramount," says Robbie. "It was also encouraging to find a school that was not only affordable but also accessible through its online courses."

It was a divine connection, so the next step was finding a place for Grace to call home in the Birmingham area. After much prayer and planning, Dave was introduced to the Hooker family, who owned a property in the growing community of Trussville. They soon met to discuss the specifics of leasing space for Grace's Alabama teaching site, and another connection was made.

"As we were talking, Mrs. Hooker said, 'How do you negotiate with God?'They saw the opportunity to use this space for ministry, and I felt very good leaving that day that God had led them to partner with us," says Dave.

After a build-out process, the Trussville facility opened last year and hosted its first intensive class this spring. "We are blessed to be a part of what God is doing through Grace in Alabama," says Robbie. "We are excited to have this facility, but the greatest blessing is not the building. We really want it to be used of the Lord, but it's really about the people, the students, and the relationships."

And for Dave, this is just the beginning of what God has in store. "We hope to establish a model here that we can duplicate in other places because our vision is not just for Alabama but the whole Southeast and eventually the whole world."
