Overview

Living Hope Church of Oregon City is an established Free Grace Bible church that is committed to loving God, loving people and giving life. We believe that the Bible is God's inerrant word to us. We are committed to practical discipleship at every level of our ministry. We actively reach out into the community with the gospel and minister to the people of this area. We have a thriving youth group with 8 high school students and 7 middle school students. The youth intern ministry is designed to give individuals first-hand experience in developing a discipleship/outreach ministry.

General Description

The youth intern will work with the executive pastor and youth staff in developing and implementing a discipleship strategy that emphasizes spiritual growth and outreach into the community. Youth ministry includes discipleship on Sunday morning and community outreach on Wednesday evenings. The youth intern will be responsible to implement a dynamic and strategic ministry for both Sunday morning and Wednesday evening. He will also assist in the strategic planning of church wide events such as summer sports camp, youth worship and youth conferences.

Expectations

- 20 to 30 years old
- Must be enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate program from an accredited college, university or seminary.
- Be a born again Christian and committed to personal spiritual growth.
- Supports the vision and mission of Living Hope Church
- In full agreement with the Free Grace theology of Living Hope Church
- Exemplify a Christian lifestyle in action, integrity, and communication.
- Strive to be prompt and exemplify good time management skills.
- Attend Wednesday staff meetings. Availability to attend staff meetings to be arranged with the executive pastor. (1:30-3:00pm)
- Meet regularly with the executive pastor for the purpose of encouragement, evaluation and leadership training.

Time Commitment

- 15 hours a week that includes Sunday morning, Wednesday night, ministry activities, staff meetings and preparation.
- Number of months: Minimum of six months. At the end of six months an evaluation will take place concerning future internships and/or hiring.

Stipend

\$15 =1 hour of work

15 hours = one week

1 Week = 15 hours X \$15 dollars= **\$225 Dollars per one week's work.**

26 weeks = six months

\$225 (one week) X 26 weeks (six months) = **\$5850 (total amount for six months at \$15 dollars per hour)**

52 weeks = 1 year

52 weeks (one year) X \$225 (weekly wage) = \$ 11,700
