#1 The Goal of Disciple-Making: The Masterpiece

Reflected the Likeness of Christ

- Acts 2:36-39 They spoke the words of Christ
- Acts 5:12-16 They did the works of Christ
- Acts 4:13 They had the boldness of Christ

Demonstrated wholehearted obedience

- Acts 4:19-22, 5:29 Obey God rather than man
- Acts 10:9-33 Cornelius—Overcame tradition

Chose Costly Sacrifice

- Acts 5:41 Worthy to suffer for Christ
- Acts 12:1-5 James is martyred

Lived a Passionate, Missional Life

- Acts 1:8 Christ's charge
- Acts 8:1 Dispersed throughout the regions

#2 The Skills of Disciple-Making: Learning to use the tools effectively

Skill #1: Change a disciple's worldview

Skill #2: Transfer truth from your life to a disciple's life

How do you instill truth in a young disciple? Where their Head (Thinks differently), Heart (Desires to follow), and Will (Choose obedience)

- Modeling
- Instruction
- Teachable Moments

Skill #3: Intentionally move a disciple towards maturity.

Phases: Transition Encounters

- John 4:1-2 Disciples were baptizing
- Mark 1:16-17 Drop your nets
- Mark 3:13-19 Calling the Apostles
- Matt 28:19-20 Mission of the Church

Skill #4: Live a life that draws them to the gospel.

How to set yourself apart

#3 The Phases of Disciple-Making: Intentional Movement

There were Four Phases (My labels)

- Inviting Phase 4-6 months
- Modeling Phase 9 months
- Releasing Phase 22 months
- Reproducing Phase The rest of their lives

Each Phase demonstrates growth in...

- Their understanding of Christ and the gospel
- Their commitment to follow him
- Their involvement in ministry

Movement was essential

There were different purposes for each Phase

Inviting Phase

Turn one's head and heart towards Christ

Modeling Phase

Gives a picture, experience, and hope for fruitful ministry

Releasing Phase

Becomes grounded, equipped, and confident

Reproducing Phase

Stands on their own

With eyes open to God's leading...
Change the world!

Pray God will bring someone into your world.

Be courageous, ask them to join you on a discipleship journey.

Be committed and diligence to be used of God.


