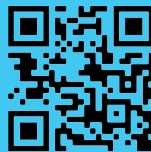

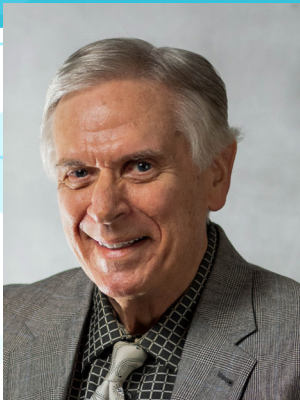

33% are shining the light of Christ in the marketplace and beyond

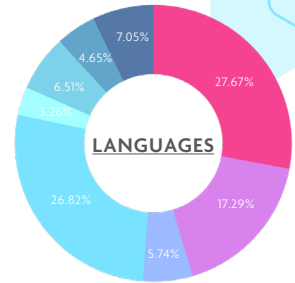
# God is using Grace School of Theology to help prepare spiritual leaders build grace-centered communities for His good purposes.

A typical graduating class spans the entire globe, with a typical semester having 640+ students from 40+ countries learning in most of the major languages.

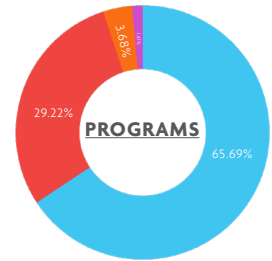

Teams of Grace students are studying and graduating with seminary degrees in Burundi, Indonesia, the Dominican Republic, Panama, and Kazakhstan.

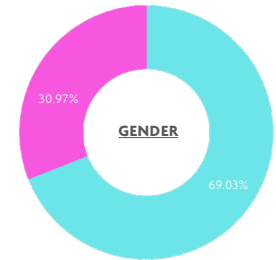

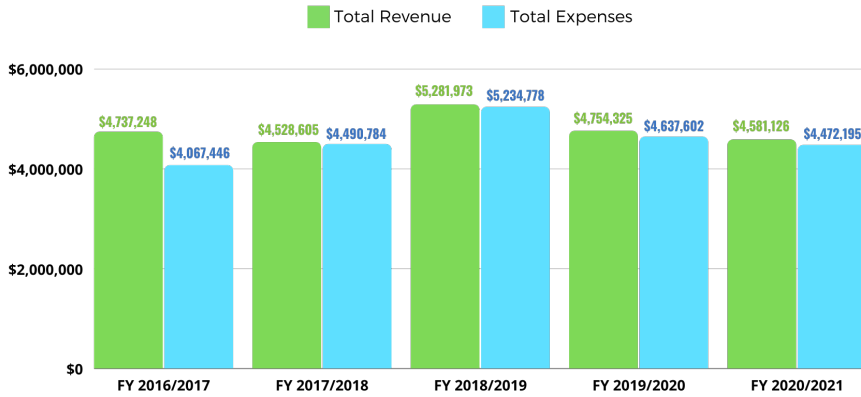
## These spiritual leaders are able to be equipped to study, teach, and lead with God's Word beyond the seminary programs we offer.

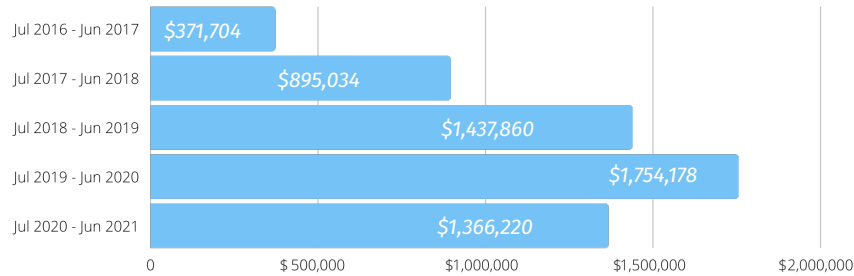
# FIVE YEAR COMPARATIVE FINANCIAL DATA

## REVENUE VS. EXPENSES

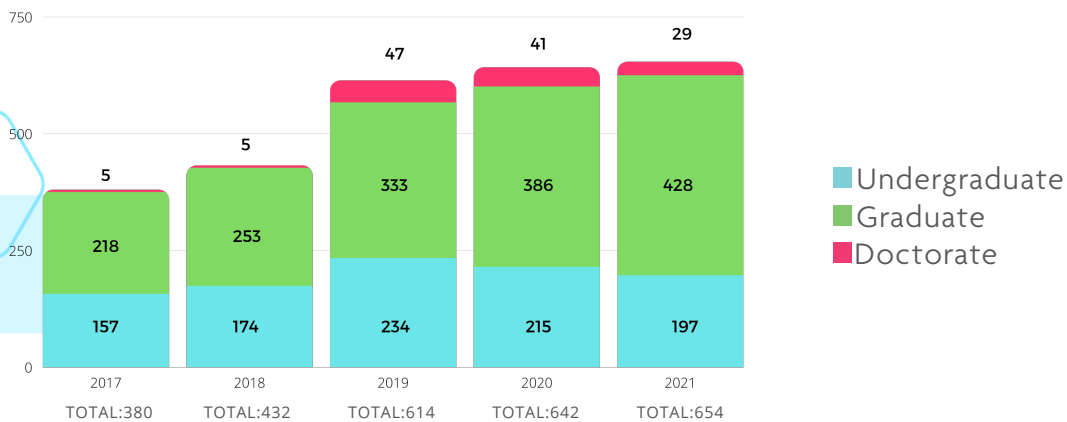
