A typical graduating class spans the entire globe, with a typical semester having 640+ students from 40+ countries learning in most of the major languages.

Teams of Grace students are studying and graduating with seminary degrees in Burundi, Indonesia, the Dominican Republic, Panama, and Kazakhstan.







FIVE YEAR COMPARATIVE FINANCIAL DATA REVENUE VS. EXPENSES
