



Girls Student Director Job Description

Reports to: Student Pastor Full-Time Position

Job Summary

The Girls Student Director will work alongside the other Student Staff and report to the Student Pastor. This Student Ministry team will function with a unified vision, clear understanding of specified responsibilities, and unified front to accomplish ministry tasks. The Girls Student Director will work with students grades 7-12. This is a full-time, exempt position.

Key Responsibilities

The Girls Student Director will have the following responsibilities on the Student Ministry team:

- 1. Shepherding of students and their parents in line with the vision of the Student Pastor.
 - a. Intentional development and investment of relationships with parents and students.
 - b. Communication with parents and students.
 - c. Equipping of parents and students toward the health, growth, and success of a Biblical worldview and paradigm of the home.
- 2. Creation, organization, implementation and success of Small Groups for students.
 - a. Development of curriculum with the Student staff for small groups.
 - b. Regular communication with small group leaders.
 - c. Engage and help execute events that small groups plan.
 - d. Help teach and engage with leaders and students as tough situations come up.
 - e. Build relationships with and work with the Student Pastor to develop the Small Group Leader Team.
 - f. Help create and manage social media posts to promote and celebrate Small Groups.
- 3. Creation, organization, implementation and success of Sunday Services for students.
 - a. Biblical teaching, prayer, fellowship and fun elements.
 - b. Attend weekly Student Staff meetings for planning and coordination of services and events.
 - c. Welcome of parents and students; creation of atmosphere that inspires comfort and belonging.
 - d. Developing and delivering biblical teaching to large groups as needed.
 - e. Help create and manage social media posts to promote and celebrate Student Service.
- 4. Organization and success of other ministry gatherings and events, including international mission trips, retreats, camps, local mission work, collaboration with other local churches, social media, school campus ministries, etc.
- 5. Other duties as assigned by Student Pastor.

- 3. Skills in communication, small group facilitation and leadership.
